Melanie,

My name is [REDACTED] and I have the website [REDACTED] with Income Store. I wish to make perfectly clear that I owned this website for years before I agreed to contract with Today's Growth/Income Store in 2016. The domain is mine and they worked within this website framework in attempt to make it profitable...of which they failed miserably.

My objections to your documents emailed to me on March 12, 2016 are as follows:

1. My contract with Income Store promised not only work on my Authority site [REDACTED] but also promised an income producing site which was to be used as instant monetization. With this in mind, I believe that Income Store's failure to generate income on either the Authority site or the income producing site still should entitle me to be part of any fund recovery measures.
2. To have only \$220,900.00 in liquid funds after bilking 100 million from over 500 investors is absurd. Does this include Mr. Courtright's personal assets such as his home, cars, savings accounts, investments, overseas accounts, etc? The monetary amount he took in was obviously used to manifest his lavish lifestyle. Is there any indication that Mr. Courtright directed these funds to overseas accounts in order to hide assets? Has the SEC been able to account for the disappearance/expenses of 100 million dollars?
3. I believe that any income produced above and beyond the contractual cost of doing business with Income Store should be returned back to the asset collection. It was shared with me on more than one occasion from Income Store representatives that Income Store favored income producing sites, giving more individualized attention and investment money to those opposed to sites that were not. Those monetary funds should be returned and be deemed a part of the asset collection since it was other investors money used to make these profits possible. This should include any profitable employees sites, Mr. Courtright's sites, as well as any and all income producing sites that existed.

In summary, I will not agree to relinquishing my rights to any return of assets in return for receiving my website back. In my case, I already own my website, and am not willing to forego my rights to any additional return of assets.
